OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject: Extension in Zero-Rating Certificates till November 30, 2020

The undersigned is directed to refer the subject cited above and state that the Federal Board of Revenue (FBR) vide Letter No. C.No.1(1)ST-LP&E/ZR/Misc/2017-pt/174493-R dated October 07, 2020 extended zero-rated certificate till September 30, 2020 of all registered persons who were earlier given zero-rated certificate till June 30, 2020.

- 2. It is stated that summary of procedure for registration under concessionary regime of electricity, RLNG and Gas under export oriented sectors has been considered in ECC of the Cabinet's meeting held on October 19, 2020. However, decision of ECC of the Cabinet is awaited which would further be ratified by the Cabinet.
- 3. As the zero-rated certificates have now expired, therefore, the DISCOS/SNGPL/SSGC issued bills on general tariff not the concessionary tariff for the companies of export oriented sectors (erstwhile zero rated sectors). Therefore, they would not be able to avail benefits under said concessionary regime utility regime.
- 3. It is requested that all those zero-rated companies which were earlier given zero-rated certificate till September 30, 2020 may please be extended to November 30, 2020 after following the codal formalities for extension (if any).
- This issues with approval of the competent authority.
